NOTICE TO INDUSTRY

Updated Government Notices listing dual use controlled goods: South African Council for the Non-Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction

The South African Council for the Non-Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction (the Council) would like to inform all relevant industry stakeholders that the Council has updated three of the Government Notices promulgated under the Non-Proliferation of Weapons of Mass Destruction Act, 1993 (Act No.87 of 1993) (Non-Proliferation Act).

The Council is a statutory body established in terms of the Non-Proliferation Act to regulate strategic (dual use) goods and technologies that could be used in the development and production of weapons of mass destruction. As contemplated in the Non-Proliferation Act, the Minister of Trade, Industry and Competition may make regulations regarding the application of the provisions of international conventions, treaties and agreements with regard to non-proliferation entered into or ratified by the Government of the Republic. On 08 April 2021, the Minister signed the following Government Notices, which has repealed the ones that were signed on 29 March 2019.

1. Government Notice No. 318 of 08 April 2021 – Declaration of certain missile technology and related items as controlled goods, and control measures, applicable to such goods.
